I would first like to thank you for your support this school year. It has been a trying nine weeks, and we have successfully navigated the first grading period of 2020 together. Your efforts are much appreciated.

As many of you know, we have done a great job of keeping the virus out, with only two confirmed cases in the buildings and no known student to student spread. Thursday October 15th and Friday October 16th we will use our first two snow days. We will still have Parent-Teacher virtual conferences as planned. We will be in session November 25th and January 18th.

We will provide lunches (Drive-thru, summer lunch style) 10.12.20-10.16.20.

The following week (October 19th-23rd) is Fall Break. It is our hope that providing this two week break we will allow everyone to rest, get well, and get ready for our push through the second nine weeks.

Please, remember social distancing and be careful of your exposure. It is my hope that we will finish our second nine weeks without interruption, and will then be able to recharge over winter break. We depend on you to help us provide our students the best education in Perry County.
